He's a life-long songwriter with a love of the craft. Honing his chops for nearly twenty years in Austin, Texas, Justin drew his inspiration from the lyrical legends whose portraits hang on the walls of venues where he got his start: Townes Van Zandt. Guy Clark. Blaze Foley. Billy Joe Shaver. Now rooted in the foothills of Virginia's Blue Ridge Mountains, he's got a country edge, a poet's heart, and a steady delivery that often has rooms grow quiet when he plays.

Over the years, Justin has challenged himself artistically, leading multiple bands and pushing his sound with a variety of collaborators across genres. After relocating to Virginia, he found front porch picking sessions, mountainside song circles, and a Saturday morning jam at the Culpeper Music Store that rekindled his love of classic country, folk music, and great songwriting that informs his current work.

His steady, John-Prine-meets-country-crooner voice adds a warm, soulful energy to any venue he plays. Expect classic country covers, familiar Americana tunes, and originals that sound fresh but like you've heard them before. His lyrics are sometimes funny, sometimes sad, sometimes like a prayer. Whether he's working the crowd in a loud bar or holding attention in a listening room, he's the kind of artist you feel lucky to have found.
